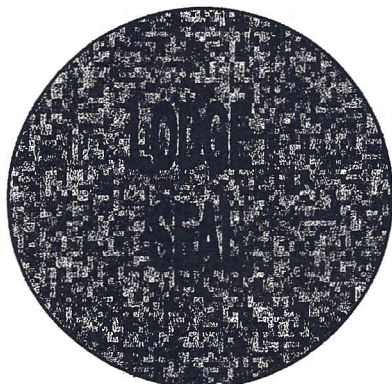

REQUIREMENTS FOR TOURNAMENT BIDS:

List of the Bowling Centers available for use by the tournament. Minimum acceptable number of lanes are 20 in one center, 28 in another center or 48 in a single center.

NYS Elks Bowling Tournament requires six (6) Bowlers per pair of lanes for Doubles and Singles events.

Attach to each bid form official documents from the centers verifying the availability of the lanes for the year of the tournament and the per line price of bowling. The price per lane must be the same for both centers, for all events conducted (TEAMS, DOUBLES and SINGLES) and the documentation must be signed by the center management.

Only those lodges completing the BID FORM and fulfilling ALL requirements correctly will be considered. It is not necessary to participate in all Grand Lodge Programs.

THE LODGE SEAL, EXALTED RULER'S SIGNATURE AND THE DATE OF THE LODGE APPROVED SUBMISSION OF THE BID MUST BE ON THE BID FORM FOR IT TO BE CONSIDERED AS OFFICIAL.

All bids must be postmarked by MIDNIGHT, APRIL 1, 2011

A lodge must send a minimum of five (5) teams for two consecutive years, present year and last year, to be eligible to bid for the Tournament.

It was approved by the NYS Elks Association that the lodge awarded the Tournament will pay the State Association the sum of \$0.40 per bowler, per event, except for All-Events. Payment to the NYS Elks Association is to be made available to the Tournament Committee at the NYSEA Annual Spring Meeting.

The time period for conducting the Tournament is set by the NYS Bowling Committee. Plans should be made to conduct the Tournament in the March through May time period.

The Host Lodge must furnish a \$100,000.00 bond. Property plus rider is acceptable.

The Host Lodge must submit to the NYS Bowling Committee the sum of \$850.00 by May 1st of the year before the Tournament.
